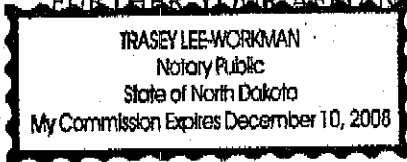
After being duly sworn and under oath, Lesa Kraft, states as follows:

1. I am the president of Sierra Corporate Design, Inc. ("Sierra").
2. In late August 2005 and again between September 3 and September 6, 2006, information about Sierra and, more particularly, its computer system, again appeared on a website believed to be operated by Defendant Ritz. The site revealed information about Sierra's computers and systems. The site upon which that information appeared was http://dritz.mako.ath.cx/20050323-newsfeeds_paths.txt (hereinafter, "the Ritz Path Site").
3. The aforementioned site was even identified in Defendant Ritz's original website (hereinafter "the Ritz Site") as a place to look for additional information about Sierra. The original site read, "For a listing of Path tails, including direct upstreams, please see http://dritz.mako.ath.cx/20050323-newsfeeds_paths.txt".
4. I have a copy of the Ritz Path Site, but have not attached it to this motion because the protective order has not yet been entered and that site contains confidential information about Sierra. However, everything listed on the Ritz Path Site pertains to Sierra's servers. It lists

Sierra's peering sites and path stamp information from Sierra's different servers and it is similar to a Sierra network diagram.

5. After Sierra's attorney sent a letter of September 6, 2005 to Defendant Ritz's lawyer stating that Sierra was bringing a motion for contempt, the Ritz Path Site was taken down.
